

Policies and Procedures

Adults:

1. Be on time. Class starts at 9:00 AM.
2. Escort your child to the classroom.
3. Keep sick children home. PLEASE!
4. Make us aware of medical allergies.
5. Provide Emergency Contact number.
6. Ask your child to discuss lesson.
7. Fire Drills will be conducted.
8. Be on time for pickup 9:50 AM.
9. Take your child to church service.
10. If you are late for pick-up, your child will be brought to church, where you will pick him or her up after the service.

Children:

1. Respect teachers and assistants.
2. Participate in activities when asked.
3. No cell phone use in the classroom.
4. No food to be brought into class.

Each child will be given a box of envelopes for gift giving. The envelopes will be collected weekly by teachers and placed in a Children's Offering Box to be brought to the church. You may write your church membership number on it for donation credit, if you wish.

Teachers will be in the classroom at 8:50 AM so that students may be dropped off. **Classes start promptly at 9:00 AM with a 45 minute lesson.**

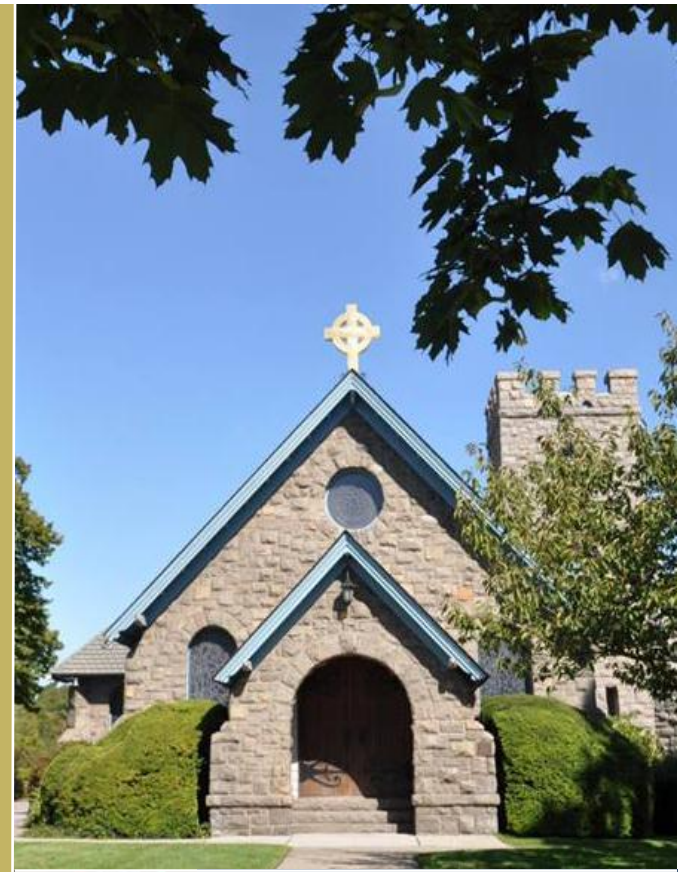
We request that parents or guardians **promptly pick up their students by 9:50 AM.** After the lesson, parents are expected to bring their children to the 10:00 AM Eucharist.
